

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The management of the Fair reserves the final and absolute right to interpret the Rules and Regulations and settle all matters in question and differences that may arise in connection with holding, management and promoting the Fair.
2. The Judge's decision will be final, unless a complaint can show fraud or other irregularity in placing the awards. The Management will not consider complaints of an incompetent judge.
3. FFA exhibit items may not be picked up until Tuesday, June 30, 2015, following the hog show and sale at the Fairgrounds. Open Horticulture and 4-H may be picked up on Wednesday from 4:00pm to 6pm at the Fairgrounds. Prize money may be claimed during this time. Open Canning exhibits and premiums are to be picked up from the Henderson County Cooperative Extension office beginning Monday, June 29 at 8am.
4. All articles must be work of the exhibitor and only finished articles accepted. Items should have been completed since the last Henderson County Fair.
5. Exhibitor assumes full responsibility for loss or damages.
6. Judging of 4-H exhibits will be on Monday, June 22 following submission of projects. Exhibit hall will be closed during this time. After the exhibits have been judged, names and ribbons will be placed on items.
7. To avoid misunderstanding, please read the rules and regulations for each division.
8. Items that have won ribbons in the past may not be entered for competition again.
9. Participants may exhibit only one item under each class number.
10. Exhibits will be open each night through the fair as posted on the schedule.
11. Open classes are open to all exhibitors unless otherwise specified.
